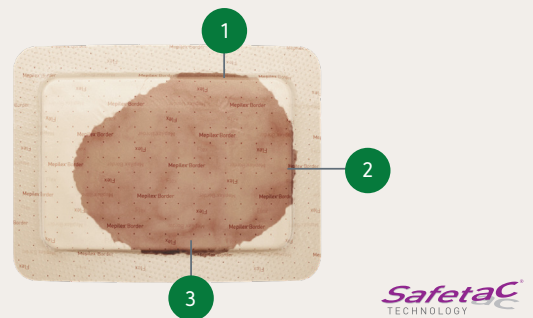

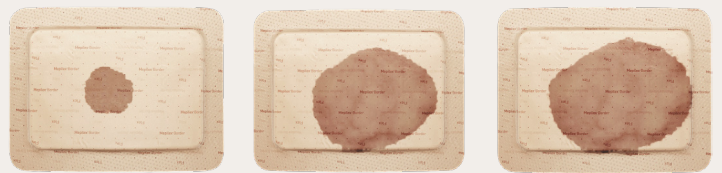
When **to** change the dressing
